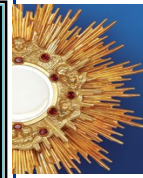

HOWEVER, THERE ARE CERTAIN ITEMS WHICH MUST NOT BE INCLUDED:  
such as candy, gum, toothpaste, toy guns, knives, military figures, anything that looks like a hand grenade, chocolate, food, seeds, fruit snacks, drink mixes, liquids, lotions, medications, vitamins, snow globes, glass containers, aerosol cans.

YOU MAY USE A PLASTIC SHOE BOX AND WRAP THE INSIDE IN GIFT WRAP;  
BUT THE LID MUST BE WRAPPED SEPARATELY AND NOT SEALED TO THE  
REST OF THE BOX. OR YOU MAY USE ONE OF THE BOXES PROVIDED.

A label stating whether it's for a boy or a girl & the age category must be taped to the outside of the box. On the inside of each box please enclose a check made out to Samaritan's Purse for \$10.00 to cover shipping & handling.

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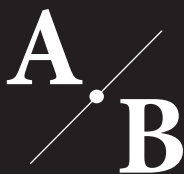
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
