### An Important Note About Accessible Parking and Entry Doors:

With our exterior church renovation complete, we now have a total of eight (8) parking spaces in proximity to the church for our parishioners with mobility issues. During weekend and weekday mass times there will be four (4) spaces reserved for handicapped parking in front of the rectory and an additional four (4) spaces in the lower parking lot adjacent to the parish hall side entrance. From there, you can use the elevator up to the church. Please note that two of the spaces in front of the rectory will be marked for accessible parking at all times, along with all four of the spaces in the lower lot.

At the main entrance in the front of the church, the left-hand-side door remains an assisted entrance with an automated door that is controlled by an exterior and an interior button. The lower-level parish hall entrance also has an automated door that can be opened from both the outside and inside.

If you are visiting the new parish offices at the O'Malley Center located at 13 Riverside Avenue, please know that there are two (2) parking spaces next to that building designated as handicapped. ### Dear Parishioners,

I am pleased to announce that our church vestibule and exterior plaza renovations have been completed and are now beautiful spaces for our parish family to enjoy. I would like to mark this special achievement by inviting all parishioners to join me for the blessing of this new narthex on the Solemnity of The Epiphany of the Lord, January 5th, 2025, after the 10:30 am mass, followed by refreshments.

We now have a wonderful vestibule where we can gather for conversation and hospitality and which can also better accommodate funeral and wedding gatherings. The new southern glass doors bring light and warmth to the space and lead to a beautiful intimate garden, ideally suited for reflection and prayer. You will notice that our vestibule also has built-in speakers so it can serve as an extension of the nave, with additional seating available for services or Masses that require it. Our newly renovated confessional is now in operation and offers generous, private space for the penitent. Our expanded exterior plaza can safely accommodate church attendees before and after services. And finally, a newly installed chime system will be heard throughout town either calling the faithful to worship or signaling various ceremonial purposes.

All of these renovations have been made with accessibility in mind. Our parishioners with mobility challenges will find easier access to the main church and enhanced parking facilities. Please see additional details regarding accessible parking in the bulletin. The renovation efforts have also allowed us to focus on security of our campus and we now benefit from a new security system throughout the church and in the Lucey Parish Hall. And finally, we have recently completed the installation of some beautiful landscaping around the perimeter of our exterior plaza.

Please note that we will have some additional plantings in the spring and that new entrance doors to our Church will be installed in January. A renovation to our mezzanine bathrooms will also take place in the early part of the New Year. These addendums to our main project were approved by the Finance Council and will be underway at the conclusion of the Christmas season.

I would like to offer my sincere gratitude to the Renovation Committee chaired by Eileen Grasso, as well as to our project partners for their professional acumen, ability to manage complexities as well as their outstanding support and involvement. The collaboration and dedication of this team has been crucial in achieving our collective goal. The teamwork displayed was nothing short of inspiring and I am proud of all that has been accomplished together. Of note, I would like to extend a special thanks to the parishioners on our team, Len D'Andrea, Max Wernert and Ben Ceci, who went above and beyond to deliver a beautiful new space for their faith community.
