



THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

"The people were full of anticipation, wondering in their hearts whether John might be the Messiah. John answered them all by saying: 'I am baptizing you in water, but there is one to come who is mightier than I...' When all the people were baptized. and Jesus was at prayer, after likewise being baptized, the skies opened, and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in visible form like a dove."


