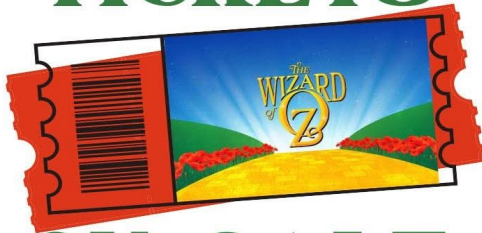

An Important Note About Accessible Parking and Entry Doors:

With our exterior church renovation complete, we now have a total of eight (8) parking spaces in proximity to the church for our parishioners with mobility issues. During weekend and weekday mass times there will be four (4) spaces reserved for handicapped parking in front of the rectory and an additional four (4) spaces in the lower parking lot adjacent to the parish hall side entrance. From there, you can use the elevator up to the church. Please note that two of the spaces in front of the rectory will be marked for accessible parking at all times, along with all four of the spaces in the lower lot.

At the main entrance in the front of the church, the lefthand-side door remains an assisted entrance with an automated door that is controlled by an exterior and an interior button. The lower-level parish hall entrance also has an automated door that can be opened from both the outside and inside.

SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"Jesus said to his disciples: 'To you who hear I say, love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. To the person who strikes you on the cheek, offer the other as well, and from the person who takes your cloak, do not withhold your tunic. Give to everyone who asks of you, and from the one who takes what is yours do not demand it back. Do to others as you would have them do to you.'"

We are familiar with the 'golden rule'. And it seems quite logical. BUT are you sure the Christian life is easy? The teaching of Jesus tells us otherwise. Maybe my task is to make sure I have no enemies, except the devil. Hate has no place in the heart of a Christian. I may disagree with someone, but no hate. I can find something positive to say about another person and always I can hold them in my prayer.

It is easy to fall, but when I listen carefully to the teaching today, I ask the grace I need, and take positive steps to put His words into practice. With Paul I can say 'I can do all things in him who strengthens me.'

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

February 21, 2024

In early December 2024, I met with Bishop Caggiano to discuss a number of things. We spoke of his desire that our parish be part of a pilot program to help more fully integrate his vision of “The One” in the diocese. (Essentially, simply promoting our existing parish life in a more unified and effective manner.) We spoke of post pandemic parish life. Finally, we discussed my personal and ministerial life as your pastor. In our discussion about my personal and ministerial life, I shared with him how the last six years have been years of constant change and growth, beginning with the renovation of the rectory and office space, the parish merger, the pandemic, the creation of our new narthex and outdoor space, the consolidation of all parish life to the St. Catherine Campus and concluding with the sale of St. Agnes Church. It has been a transformative time for the parish, and as such, a time of constant change and adaptation. At times it has felt all consuming, but in God’s grace, also very productive.

The bishop then asked if I had ever taken a sabbatical as a priest. I said, “No bishop in nearly 37 years of priesthood, I haven’t. As a matter of fact, it’s been hard to even get a vacation in the last six years.” He asked if I would like to take a sabbatical. I’m usually a person who likes to deliberate a bit, but not in this case, I said “sure” immediately. He said, “let’s do that.”

On March 1, 2025, I will begin a three-month sabbatical. Originally the plan was for to leave at the beginning of January to be back during Lent, however Father Miguel Bernal needed to return to Spain to renew his visa and the sabbatical was delayed. Now it looks like Father Bernal will be returning soon, I’ll leave upon his return. Fr. Bernal and Fr. Perrella will jointly administer the parish during my sabbatical and parish life will continue in the ordinary course.

When the sabbatical was to begin in January, I thought that I might spend it on retreat and auditing some theology classes at Ave Maria University in Florida. Now, with the delay, I will still make an Ignatian retreat but probably do more of a directed study with a priest mentor. I anticipate departing the rectory during the first week of March and returning at the beginning of June 2025.

It will be good to have some time away, and I thank Bishop Caggiano for this opportunity to both rest and reflect. I’m sure that being away will have its own challenges. Parish life has become my life in many respects. Please pray for me as I will for you. St. Catherine of Siena and St. Agnes, pray for us.
