

First Sunday of Lent

An Important Note About Accessible Parking and Entry Doors:

With our exterior church renovation complete, we now have a total of eight (8) parking spaces in proximity to the church for our parishioners with mobility issues. During weekend and weekday mass times there will be four (4) spaces reserved for handicapped parking in front of the rectory and an additional four (4) spaces in the lower parking lot adjacent to the parish hall side entrance. From there, you can use the elevator up to the church. Please note that two of the spaces in front of the rectory will be marked for accessible parking at all times, along with all four of the spaces in the lower lot.

At the main entrance in the front of the church, the lefthand-side door remains an assisted entrance with an automated door that is controlled by an exterior and an interior button. The lower-level parish hall entrance also has an automated door that can be opened from both the outside and inside.

- ♦ Days of Fasting: On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, all Catholics age 18-59 are required to fast the entire day. While fasting, one full meal is permitted, as well as two small meals/snacks that do not together add up to a full meal. If fasting would be hazardous to your health, you are permitted to adjust the practice accordingly.
- ♦ <u>Days of Abstinence</u>: On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent that do not coincide with a Solemnity (namely, the Solemnity of St. Joseph and the Solemnity of the Annunciation), all Catholics age 14 and older are required to abstain from eating meat.
- Both St. Catherine Church and St. Agnes Chapel are open during the day for private prayer. The church is open weekdays from 8am-4pm, and the chapel is open weekdays from 8am-6pm.
