PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

"Christ Jesus, though he was in true form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness, and found human in appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."

Scholars tell us that this prayer of Saint Paul was probably a hymn, detailing the unlimited love of God for us. He became one of us, to identify with us in our need, but not abandoning His Godhead. He emptied Himself, gave everything of Himself in His death, with only one thing in mind, that we might have a new life.

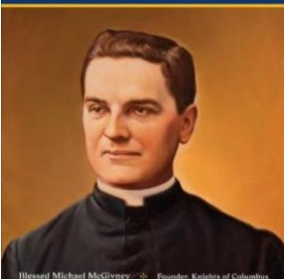

- ◆ **Days of Fasting:** On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, all Catholics age 18-59 are required to fast the entire day. While fasting, one full meal is permitted, as well as two small meals/snacks that do not together add up to a full meal. If fasting would be hazardous to your health, you are permitted to adjust the practice accordingly.
- ◆ **Days of Abstinence:** On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent that do not coincide with a Solemnity (namely, the Solemnity of St. Joseph and the Solemnity of the Annunciation), all Catholics age 14 and older are required to abstain from eating meat.
- ◆ Both St. Catherine Church and St. Agnes Chapel are open during the day for private prayer. The church is open weekdays from 8am-4pm, and the chapel is open weekdays from 8am-6pm.
