RICH SOIL IS OUR RESPONSIBILITY

Message from Our
Pastor

Each day a thousand messages strike our ears, but only a few find their way into our minds and plant themselves in our hearts. "Buy a new car!" "The mortgage bill is due." "Relax, slow down!" "Dessert is ready!" These and other words strike our ears, but only some will wind up planting themselves in our hearts.

The same is true when we hear the Gospel. What happens to God's Word when it reaches our ears? Does it enter my mind, take root in the rich soil of my heart, and change the way that I live? Or does it roll off and fall on the path, on rocky ground or in brambles?

At some point in our lives God's seed has found rich soil and taken root in us or else we wouldn't be reading this today. But if we're honest with ourselves, sometimes it doesn't. Sometimes other things grab our attention and as a result God's Word gets lost. How can I more permanently open my ears and mind to the Gospel? How can I better prepare good soil in my heart to receive Christ's seed?

Good soil doesn't come by accident; it takes a lot of work. One must uproot trees, clear brush, and remove rocks to produce rich soil. In the same way, to prepare our hearts for Christ's word, we must root out sin and remain focused on our goal which is heaven- we do this through the Sacraments (namely the Eucharist and Confession), through prayer, reading God's Word and other spiritual reading, and through the presence and friendship of other good Christians in our lives. Through this kind of cultivation of our souls, we will surely produce thirty, sixty, or a hundred-fold.
