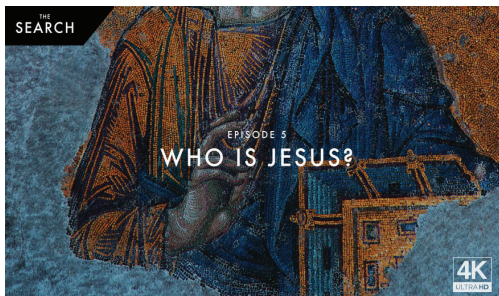
Sacred Art: Christ the King
