ST. AGNES CHURCH CELEBRATION

On June 2, as a parish family of faith, we will celebrate the legacy of St. Agnes Church. United in love, we will place dearly held memories of St. Agnes Church within the broader context of our faith in Jesus Christ. It will be a celebration to commemorate the shared heritage of our merged parish and the decades of faithful service to the Church by the parishioners of St. Agnes.

Jamie Benincasa, a parish trustee, and former St. Agnes parishioner has been working with a group of parish volunteers to plan the event. The celebration will begin with the celebration of the 10:30 am Mass. A highlight of the Mass will be the inaugural presentation of a new hymn written by our Composer-in-Residence, Alexander Dmitriev, in honor of St. Agnes – “The St. Agnes Hymn.” Following the Mass, there will be a solemn procession to the chapel, where the statue of St. Agnes (from the St. Agnes Church sanctuary) will be permanently enshrined for veneration and devotion. *Additionally, Bishop Caggiano has issued a decree naming the chapel after St. Agnes, and the parish council unanimously supports the decree.* A reception will follow.
