- To ensure that all religious artifacts have been properly sheathed, labeled and secured in a safe location. It is expected that these artifacts will be restored and brought back at the conclusion of the renovation.
- To install the south entrance ramp (next to the rectory) and a safe and secure temporary entrance for all to use during the renovations.
- To work on setting up a temporary fire alarm system that will protect both the construction and church areas during the course of the project.
