



Church Renovation Update #5

We are happy to report that the interior construction is progressing well and remains on schedule. Plumbing, HVAC & electrical inspections have been conducted and passed, and sheetrock is being installed on the walls. The design for the south entrance stoop has been finalized and we expect to begin construction of the south entrance stoop and garden patio the first week of May, to be complete by the first week of June (you can see the image of the stoop design below).

The Finance Committee has also approved two additional projects. The first project is the much-needed refresh of the mezzanine bathrooms to include new motion sensor sinks, vanities, partitions, lighting and paint. The second new initiative will be the implementation of an interior and exterior security system to include new and easier-to-use electronic key systems and monitoring that will provide enhanced safety measures for the parish.
