Our Lord Jesus Christ, King Of The Universe

As they approached to offer him wine they called out 'If you are king of the Jews, save yourself' Above him there was the inscription that read, 'This is the King of the Jews'... 'Jesus remember me when you come into your kingdom.' He replied to him, 'Amen I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise.'

From the earliest gospel teaching we heard Jesus speak of the kingdom. The parables offered us countless examples of what the kingdom is like. As we stand at the cross on Calvary today, we honor the king and identify as members of His kingdom. How often people when viewing a crucifix ask, 'what does INRI mean?'. The gospel text tells us Who it is hanging there in order to save us. Like the repentant thief, we ask that He remember us today, and yearn to hear Him say, 'I assure you, today you will be with me in paradise.'




