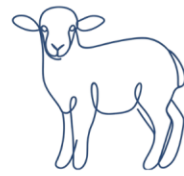

Baptism Guidelines

Registration

Parents baptizing their children at St. Catherine of Siena and St. Agnes should be registered parishioners, regularly attending mass. You can register as a parishioner on our parish website.

If you are not planning on becoming a parishioner, you will need a letter from the pastor of your home parish, granting permission for the baptism of your child.

Preparation

For children under 7, parents must undergo preparation before presenting their first child to be baptized. To enroll in pre-baptismal preparation, please fill out the form on the baptism page of the parish website, and you will be contacted to coordinate the details.

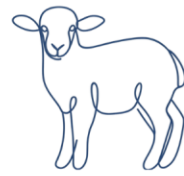
Children 7 years old and older must undergo faith formation prior to receiving the sacrament of Baptism. For more information on faith formation, please see the faith formation page on the parish website.

Time & Location

Baptisms are held on Sundays at 1pm in the main church. Multiple baptisms may be scheduled on the same date.

Church Fees

The church fee for the celebration of the sacrament is **\$300**.

By Check. If paying by check, payment must be received **at least one week prior to the date of the sacrament**. Checks should be made payable to: **St. Catherine of Siena and St. Agnes Parish**

We kindly ask families to submit payment in a timely manner so that all arrangements may be completed prior to the celebration of the sacrament. Thank you for your cooperation and for allowing our parish community to accompany you during this special and grace-filled occasion.

Godparents

A godparent's role is to be able to be a witness to living an active faith in Jesus Christ and to be able to pass this on to your child by word and example. In addition, they also have the responsibility to ensure that your child is raised and educated in our Faith if, for some reason, you are unable to fulfill this promise. To perform their role, the godparents should be people who will be close to your child and actively involved in his/her life. Both godparents must be at least 16 years old.
