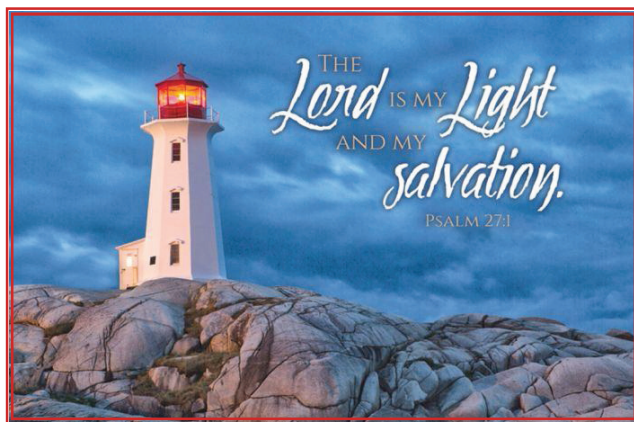

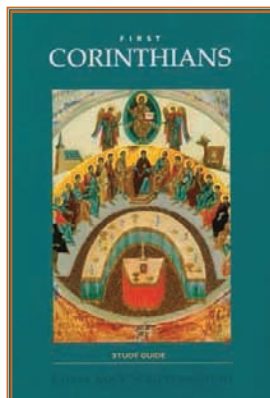

1). All donation checks should be made payable to:

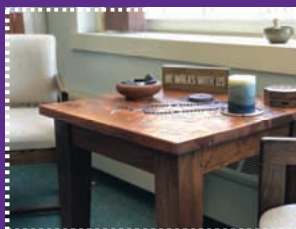

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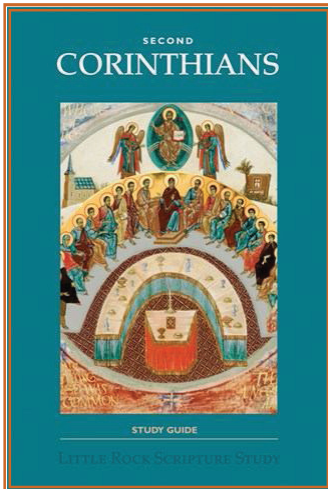

New Bible Study Series is Here!

Our next 7-week study is entitled **"Second Corinthians"** incorporating an Introductory session and 6 lessons.

This **7-session study** uses the second half of the commentary used with **First Corinthians** (*First and Second Corinthians* by Maria Pascuzzi).

Maria A. Pascuzzi, CSJ, STD, teaches Scripture at the *University of San Diego*. She has a *Liscentiate in Sacred Scripture* from the Pontifical Biblical Institute and her *Doctorate in Sacred Theology* is from the Gregorian University.

Come to know the forceful but loving character of Paul, one of the best known figures in the early Church. No other letter from Paul is so revealing of Paul's personality. Paul likens the ministry of Apostles as that of being ambassadors of God whose message is one of reconciliation. Arguing from his own experience of discipleship and ministry, Paul continues to promote unity in a divided and confused Corinth by reflecting on his own weaknesses as an opportunity to find strength in Christ. He calls the Corinthians to generosity in care for the poor who live outside their own community.

There is a **\$30 materials fee** (\$22 for **First Corinthians** students) which is to be paid the 1st day of class. Cash or check accepted.

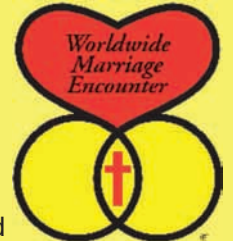

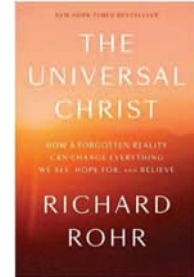

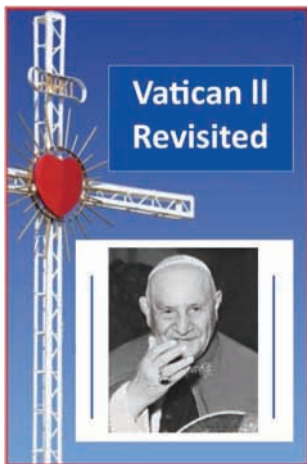

A short series of thoughts on the impact of this historic, critically defining event of our Church not just for the 20th century, but for this new millennium as well **Part 2**

Formal preparation for the Second Vatican Council, commonly called Vatican II, began with a worldwide consultation with some 2500 bishops, heads of male (it was 1959, after all) religious orders, and faculties of Catholic universities. The consultation got underway through an Invitation sent in June of 1959 by Pope St. John XXIII asking the bishops of the world to express what ideas and subjects should be addressed. More than 2000 responses were received. All this material was collated by nation and printed in book form. The books were then passed along to a group of preparatory commissions. These commissions were composed of cardinals, bishops, and other church workers noted for their virtue and learning and chosen from different parts of the world, so that the universality of the Church might be displayed. The commissions then prepared position papers for the bishops of the world to consider in the general meetings of the Council itself.

This Council would undertake major questions that had been before the Church for many centuries without open discussion such as:

- ◇ the role of bishops in their relationship to the Pope
- ◇ the role and place of lay people in the life of the Church
- ◇ the Church's teaching on divine revelation and its source
- ◇ the understanding of religious liberty in the modern age
- ◇ the reform and restoration of the Liturgy

And most remarkably and without precedence, the place and relationship of the Church to the whole modern world, with all its challenges and needs, including its place in the lives of all people, Catholics, other Christians, non Christians, non believers and all people of good will. The Council would meet each Fall for ten or more weeks from 1962 to 1965.

And so, on October 11, 1962, the Second Vatican Council was formally opened. Early that morning a large crowd gathered in St. Peter's Square. At precisely 8:00 A.M., the doors to the papal apartments were slowly opened. Behind these doors stood row upon row upon row of bishops, patriarchs, archbishops, abbots and scarlet clad cardinals. They were poised to descend the staircase and process out of the Vatican palace down into the square and into St. Peter's basilica, more than 2500 in all! Their faces were the colors of the world. More than 500 were from Central and South America, 126 were native Asians, 118 were Africans and the rest were from Europe and North America.

The crowd witnessed the beginning of an historic event. For on that day, the windows of the Church were thrown open by Pope St. John XXIII. They were thrown open and light burst into the chambers long darkened by a too rigid, too triumphal application of the decrees of the Council of Trent. "Divine Providence is leading us to a new order of human relations", the Pope exclaimed in his homily that day. "It's time", the Pope went on to say, "for the Church to bring herself up to date in all areas were required." In the coming weeks, we shall examine how the Church went on to do that in the three years that followed that historic day more than 57 years ago. Hopefully, you'll read on.

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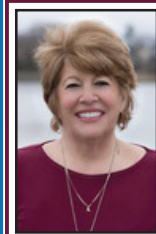
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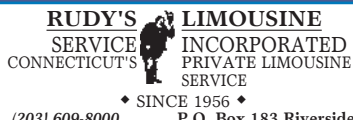
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
