

Early Encounters: European and Asian Cultures at the Crossroads Sunday, November 21

11:45 AM in St. Catherine's Lucey Parish Hall

Robert Henrey has resumed his 2021 lecture series, **Early Encounters: European and Asian Cultures at the Crossroads (1500-1850)**. His goal has been to share his long-standing interest in the historical, religious and linguistic backdrop to the complex but fascinating story of how adventurers, traders and scholarly missionaries brought back home a growing awareness of the richness they had encountered.

The series began this past spring with a four-part, virtual discussion of how 16th century Portuguese maritime dominance dramatically accelerated a process of mutual awareness that stretched back to the Ancient World and how India, with its long history of attracting and fostering diverse cultures, became the stepping stone for those looking to explore yet farther eastward. This fall series continues the story, by inviting discussion on how westerners made early inroads into China and Japan thanks, in large part, to the remarkable achievements of

Jesuit missionaries – with dramatically different and unforeseen outcomes. These in-person, illustrated presentations also address how East and West gradually became aware of each other's cultures leading to our increasingly interconnected world and are designed to stimulate discussion--the process of mutual understanding is taking on increasing urgency and is far from over! Join us for this final event after the 10:30 AM Mass!

Day Food Collection



We Stand With Christ Capital Campaign



On October 30 and 31st we announced the **We Stand With Christ** capital campaign at the Parish of St. Catherine of Siena and St. Agnes!

Our Parish has a goal of \$3,000,000 - \$3,500,000, and we have already raised \$2,270,000 in pledges, or 76% of our initial goal from 51 families.

71% of the funds raised by our Parish will support St. Catherine of Siena and St. Agnes's capital priorities, which include: 1). Establishing a Parish-Wide Service Fund, 2). Creating a New Reconciliation Room and Enlarging the Indoor Gathering Space at St. Catherine's, 3). Creating a Welcoming Outdoor Gathering Space at St. Catherine's, and 4). Laying the Foundation for a Spiritual Life Center at our St. Agnes Campus.

Today we highlight our third capital initiative:

Creating a Welcoming Outdoor Gathering Space at St. Catherine's Church

Our one-way traffic circle at St. Catherine's often causes congestion and limits our parishioners' ability to congregate before and after weddings, funerals, and popular masses (Easter Vigil, Christmas vigil, etc.). Our plan is to expand and re-route parish traffic while also improving traffic safety and modernizing our handicap accessibility.


