

Ukrainian Women's Bake Sale Helps 200+ Children in Need!

The Ukrainian women's bake sale following the Bishop's visit to St. Catherine's in December netted \$2,500 from our parish! According to one of the groups' leaders, Oksana Voytenko, they sent our collection to **People 2 People,** a 503 (c) charitable human services organization: https://people2peoplefoundation.org/. They have decided to give your donations to an **orphanage** called **Zhuravno**. This orphanage was initially evacuated to the **Lviv** region from **Zaporizhzhia** with **80 kids**, all of whom have some sort of neurological disorder or diagnosis. As the war continued, more children from **Mykolaiv** and **Kherson** were moved to join this group. Right now there are **200 children** at the orphanage, the **majority** of whom are little – **under school age**, but about **30 children** are of **school age** as well. Most of the children have autism or a similar condition.

In this orphanage, there are many issues with the food delivery, power and heat. They will be spending your donation on groceries and two new generators, as the generators they have are not powerful enough to function sufficiently. They will also buy diesel fuel for the generators, which may take several weeks to arrive and be installed.
