OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD A PROJECT OF SAMARITAN'S PURSE

This is a reminder to fill your shoe boxes. If you need another box, please **contact Betsy Parker** at socialjustice@stc-sta.org or **Janet Wrabel** at janet.wrabel@stc-sta.org. Or you may use a plastic shoe box—this is an extra benefit as it can be used to hold water for washing. If you do use a plastic box and want to wrap it, remember to wrap the lid separately from the bottom and don't seal them together. The boxes need to be opened for inspection.

Hint: place the wrapping on the inside so that it won't tear in transit.

Tape the label stating whether it is for a boy or a girl and the age category on the outside of the box. On the inside, **include a check** made out to **Samaritan's Purse** for the amount of **\$10.00**. This will cover the cost of shipping and handling.

Please be aware that there are certain items which MUST NOT be included such as candy, gum, toothpaste, toy guns, knives, military figures, anything that looks like a hand grenade, chocolate, food, seeds, fruit snacks, drink mixes, liquids, lotions, medications, vitamins, snow globes, glass containers, aerosol cans.

The deadline for returning boxes is November 12. Please place the completed boxes on the table at the entrance of the church.

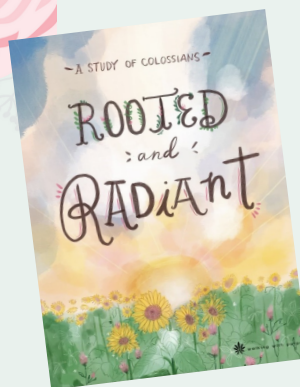
FAITH FORMATION for Adults & Youth

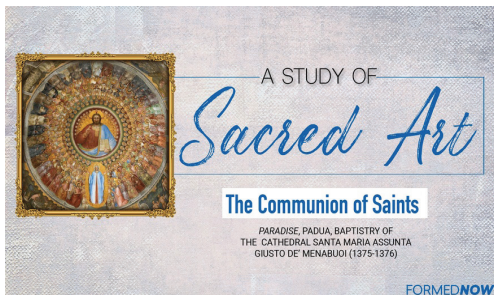
